A Business Session Board Meeting of the Elizabeth School District was held on May 3, 2021 in the Board Room, District Office.

1.0 CALL TO ORDER

4.0 EDUCATION SHOWCASE

Elizabeth Middle School Principal, Pamela Eschief, shared an update on the MAPS testing that took place at the middle school earlier this year, the results were overall positive. The teachers were happy with the results and now have a good idea on where to focus on development for each grade level 6-8th. The 7th graders are continuing to learn The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens in Ms. Neelley's class and have been really enjoying the book, as it relates to teens. National Junior Honor Society has been busy with their fundraisers including penny war, holiday hallway decorating, pie day, teachers vs. 8th grade student kickball game, the giving tree and many more. Student council has also been busy in fundraising and volunteer activities including canned food drive, and fundraisers for Thanksgiving, Christmas and St. Patrick's Day. Lastly, at the end of May 36 students will be celebrated for their Student of the Month award with a breakfast sponsored by EMS counselors.

7.0 COMMUNICATIONS

7.1 HR Update

Director of HR Kin Shuman provided an update on the annual spreadsheets with the staff recommendations the district would like to bring back next year (21-22) including their salaries. Open enrollment for benefits is now open and information is being sent to all eligible employees. In addition to standard benefits, the district partners with American Fidelity to provide benefits to staff that the district doesn't offer. Lastly, the Director of Marketing and Communications position is moving forward with initial interviews being set-up with the Superintendent. The hiring process will look very similar to the hiring process for the middle school principal position.

7.2 Technology Update

Technology Director Marty Silva provided an update on purchasing additional Chrome Books; the team is currently working on getting out RFP's, they will be separated out by each school's needs. MLO funding was freed up due to the Chrome Books being purchased by COVID funding, so the MLO funding went to purchase a new computer lab for Candice Tauger's room at the high school. In addition to ten new computers for the STEM program at the middle school and 67 iPads for Running Creek and Singing Hills. Running Creek was also able to purchase podcasting equipment. A new work order system is being rolled out district wide, where the google devices will be added into the new work order system for a more streamlined approach.

7.3 Financial Update

Chief Financial Director Ron Patera reviewed checks over \$5,000 which includes typical monthly expenses, mostly utilities, fuel and food. Some of the other expenditures include payments for SPED services, technology needs, professional development materials, online learning, and a wall sign and out of district tuition. Financial statements reflect activity through the end of March or 75% through the fiscal year. There has been 71.27 percent of the general fund budget expended year to date and we have collected 64.57% of budgeted revenues. A couple of the cost centers are over the 75% benchmark, but overall 3 and ¾% under budget. Of the remaining funds the only one that needs to be closely monitored the balance of the year is the Food Service Fund. For the time being the legislature is scheduled to conclude this session in mid-June. So we will not know exactly what our final funding for the upcoming school year will look like. The capital needs worksheet has been modified to reflect prioritizing from staff, along with the estimated expense of the project/purchase. As you can see in the assumptions worksheet we are anticipating a slight increase in the number of students attending the district next year. This year has been aberration and hopefully this upcoming school year will be a return to some form of normalcy. We do anticipate increases in worker's compensation and property and liability insurance. There will not be an increase in the employer portion of PERA; however, we do anticipate an increase in SPED expenses, not including increased staffing needs. Lastly, Ron met with all office managers, principals and both athletic directors to discuss next year's budget.

7.4 Superintendent Update



Superintendent Bissonette shared and congratulated the Elizabeth High School Gymnastics team who won the State Championship! The girls participate in a 4A division, which is incredibly competitive and has a number of high school students that come together to form one team. The Elizabeth High School Gymnastics team is an incredibly strong united team; they work together and know it is a team sport. Teacher appreciation week is this week, all the thanks and appreciation they receive is much deserved with the unconventional year they had around dual learning (remote and in-person). On the classified salary schedule we have the position, Lead Preschool Teacher, not a licensed position as we have it currently listed. Proposition EE will begin funding preschool in the coming years; the district needs to begin to focus on how the expectations may begin changing (i.e. requiring certified preschool teachers, increase the quantity of preschool teachers). This will present opportunities for additional qualifications and potentially higher pay for those teachers. It will also allow those teachers to contribute to the curriculum of the preschool students. Lastly, next school year the district is not planning to incorporate a high-bred model of learning, if students want to participate in 100% online learning there are many programs available to students outside out of the district, however, it will not be a focus for the district. In terms of requirements around masks next year, the district will follow the state mask guidelines; unsure of what they will be in August of 2021. The ability of our schools to stay safe when there is a spread of COVID (uptick in cases) in the community is a testament to how safe school is for students. The decision to stay in person and not affecting the lives of the 630 students was understood by a mass majority of our parents. The letter sent to CDHP by a number of superintendents to remove guarantine guidelines around schools, was met with a negative response due to their interpretation of a rise in community positive cases.
