Summary

School safety is multifaceted and complex. A holistic approach is required to ensure a layered security solution is achieved. The goal and mission of the safety department is to provide a safe and secure learning environment that supports positive learning.

The ESD Safety Department focuses on five mission areas geared towards an all-hazard response process: prevention, protection, mitigation, response, and recovery. These five capabilities enhance our layered security approach (deter, detect, delay, deny, and respond).

 - High security keyway






Tabletop Drills

- Conducted with each school
- Established Safety Teams in accordance with ICS/NIMS
- ICS roles and duties
- SRP familiarization
- Evacuation/Reunification procedures
- Team oriented scenarios





IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



STUDENTS Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

ADULTS Close and lock the door Account for students and adults Do business as usual

SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors. STUDENTS Return to inside of building Do business as usual

ADULTS

Bring everyone indoors Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual

Maintain silence Do not open the door

LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight. STUDENTS ADULTS Recover students from hallway if possible Move away from sight

Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend

EVACUATE! (A location may be specified) STUDENTS Leave stuff behind if required to

If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

ADULTS Lead students to Evacuation location Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults

SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. STUDENTS ADULTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

Lead safety strategy Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students Safety Strategy Evacuate to shelter area or adults

Hazmat Seal the room Earthquake Drop, cover and hold Tsunami Get to high ground

REUNIFY

Raptor Visitor Management

- Electronic visitor management system
- Web-based Access
 - Accessible from any internet capable device
- Identification Data Capture
 - Reads 2D barcode on driver's license
- Instant Screening
 - Runs checks against the SOR
- Immediate Alert Notifications
 - SMS/email push notifications
- Unique Visitor Badges
 - Name, school, date, photo, location



Electronic Maps/Door Numbers

- Updated electronic building maps
- Identifies all critical areas inside each school
- Door swing direction, corridors #'s, room #'s, door #'s
- Shared with local first responders (including DCSO)
- Accessible via CAD/MDT
- Blueprint copies available for first responders
- Integrates with new access control system





Law Enforcement Knox Boxes

- Rapid access and entry systems
- Designated solely for law enforcement
- Installed at main entrances
- Provides law enforcement with essential keys
