Purpose of Upgrade

- 1. Upgrade overall fuel structure
 - Double wall tank
 - Secondary containment for below ground piping
 - Monitoring alarms for tank and piping
 - Compliance with UL2085 rating
- 2. Reduce risk of accidental release from system failure
- 3. Fewer trips by large tankers reduces accident risks
- Compliance with current EPA/Colorado Department of Oil and Public Safety Standard
- 5. Reduce future costs by making bulk purchases
- Example of community partnership by utilizing the hard work of IAC membership

- Involved appropriate regulatory and oversight agencies
- Contracted with vendor
- Set up back-up system in event project wasn't complete by school year start
- Installed new system
- Tested system
