



DAC Charges – 2024-25

Standard Charges from Bylaws:

- A. Ensure that DAC charges have been cooperatively determined, at least annually, by the DAC and the Superintendent.
- B. Fulfill the charges established by the DAC in a timely basis.
- C. Ensure that any proposed changes in DAC By-Laws are forwarded to the Board of Education for consideration of action.
- D. Ensure that each parent member reports to his or her school's staff and accountability committee regarding the activities of the DAC after each monthly DAC meeting and forward any input from or to the DAC.
- E. Make recommendations to the Board of Education regarding prioritization for spending district monies.
- F. Ensure that all responsibilities are managed in accord with the Board of Education policies, district regulations, and state statutes.

Specific Charges for 2024-25 School Year

- A. Develop and propose school calendars for the 2026-27 school year that take into account the educational needs of our students and provide a minimum of 170 school days. This calendar should balance the first and second semester within 6 days of each other to allow for common instructional periods in each semester. The DAC may produce more than one calendar if it wishes the board to make the final decision from those proposed.
- B. Analyze academic achievement across the district utilizing both state and local data to determine areas of need
- C. Support the school administrators in the development of the annual Unified Improvement Plan both for the schools (SAC) and the District (DAC)
- D. Assist the district with determining whether it should pursue a mill levy or bond initiative for the fall of 2025
- E. Review and provide feedback to the board on charter applications received in the district.
