6th Grade Elective Course Descriptions

Intro to Art

Practice your basic art skills in drawing, painting, sculpture, and more. Discover the art and artists from diverse eras and locations, and explore various art styles.

Beginning Band ****Year Long Class****

Come learn to play a band instrument. Band instruments include all woodwinds, brass, and percussion. Pick an instrument to play, learn the basics, and play with some amazing people! No experience is required!! Just the love of music and an interest in music. Performances in two after-school concerts are required per semester. ***(Students can be placed in Intermediate or Advanced Band upon teacher recommendation).***

Beginning Orchestra ****Year Long Class****

Come and learn an orchestra instrument. Orchestra instruments are violin, viola, cello, and double bass. Pick an instrument to play, learn the basics, and play with your classmates! No experience is required! Just a love for music and an interest in playing an instrument. Performances in two after-school concerts are required per semester. ***(Students can be placed in Intermediate or Advanced Orchestra upon teacher recommendation).***

Choir

Explore singing with a choir! Even if you think you can't sing, this is the place to discover your talents and harmonize with your peers! There will be two required evening performances.

Theatre

Want to be an actor? Learn about the stage and how to perform both in groups and on your own.

Perform your own stories, learn theatre terminology, how to improvise, and memorization techniques!

Computer Science Discoveries

Take your knowledge of computer science to the next step! In this class, we will review our understanding of block coding and begin exploring more advanced applications, including animation, game design, 3D modeling, and robotics.

Introduction to Engineering

Are you interested in building a bridge? Would you like to design and build a car and then see it speed across the cafeteria? If so, Introduction to Engineering could be the class for you! Skills including measuring, proper tool usage, and group problem-solving will be utilized in this class.

PE

It combines both fun and educational activities that promote teamwork, individual effort, and sportsmanship.
